On 25 June this year, in the Awangarda BWA Gallery in Wrocław took place a vernissage of the exhibition "Gravity. For Tymoteusz Karpowicz" by Krzysztof M. Bednarski. The event was supported by ERBUD SA, one of the five largest construction groups in Poland.

The exhibition of one of the most outstanding Polish contemporary sculptors is held in Wroclaw, the city honoured with the title of the 2016 European Capital of Culture. Krzysztof M. Bednarski, who lives in Rome and Warsaw, is, among others, known for his works from the series "Moby Dick" that has been proclaimed an artistic manifesto of the second half of the eighties.
